Aerojet Rocketdyne, Inc. (AR) is reaching out to all suppliers that support Department of Defense (DoD) Missile Defense Agency (MDA) Programs to alert you to a cybersecurity issue and request your immediate action.

AR has received several letters from the DoD MDA (or our prime contractors) noting a cybersecurity concern. You may be aware that the National Security Agency (NSA) has discovered a critical vulnerability (CVE-2020-0601) affecting Microsoft Windows. The vulnerability impacts Windows 10, Windows Server 2016 and 2019, and applications that rely on Windows for trust functionality.
